

What are the Requirements to Lead a Workplace Small Group?

1. What are the requirements to Host a small group at Saddleback?

- a. A leader must be a member of Saddleback Church.
- b. A leader must commit to completing all remaining CLASSES 201, 301 and 401 within six months.
- c. A leader must complete Leader Training (LT-1) and agree to implement the Leader Values on the Leader Application.
- d. A leader must be able to answer that there are no problems with the following areas:
 - 1) Leader must not have current habitual struggles or moral issues (drugs, alcohol, cohabitation, etc.) that would bring shame on the name of Jesus Christ or on Saddleback Church.
 - 2) In addition, there must not be any current marital struggles (i.e. infidelity, separation, divorce in process, etc.)
 - 3) Finally, the leader must support Saddleback Church's Statement of Faith without any reservation or addition.

2. What do I need to do to become a Saddleback member?

- a. You need to have accepted Jesus Christ as your Lord and Savior
- b. Leader must be baptized by immersion at Saddleback Church or at an acceptable Bible teaching church..
- c. Leader must have completed 'Membership CLASS 101, and have signed our membership covenant that is available in CLASS 101.
